### Section XVII

Vehicles and transport equipment

General notes.

- 1. The statistical reporting of road vehicles, air craft und ships applies not only to the vehicles themselves but also to the accessories imported or exported with them (e.g. boilers, propulsion machinery, electrical equipment and instruments) provided they are usually regarded as normal fixtures of such vehicles.
- 2. The following articles are excluded from this Section: A. In all cases:
  - a) Mobile motor pumps, compressors, ladders, cranes or other lifting or handling apparatus of a kind running on rails only (Chapter 84);
  - b) Electrical signalling equipment for railways (Chapter 85);
  - c) Childrens' vehicles (Chapter 97).
  - B. When they do not form a normal part of the equipment of the vehicle with which they are imported or exported
    - or when they are imported or exported separately:
    - a) Rubber tyres, covers or matting (Chapter 40);
    - b) Springs, transmission chains (Chapter 73 and 74);
    - c) Base metal non-electric lighting fixtures (Chapter 83);
    - d) Steam-generating boilers, including auxiliary boiler appliances and accessories; internal combustion engines and reaction engines and parts thereof; ladders, cranes and other lifting- or handling apparatus designed for equipping special vehicles; bearings of all kinds (Chapter 84);
    - e) Electrical generators and motors, accumulators and primary batteries and cells, electric ignition, selfstarting, lighting or signalling equipment for cycles, motor vehicles, aircraft or motor-vessels, wireless equipment or other electrical equipment and fittings for vehicles (Chapter 85);
    - f) Counting and metering apparatus, measuring instruments, navigational and other similar instruments (Chapter 90);
    - g) Clocks, chronometers or watches and parts thereof (Chapter 91).
- 3. Aircraft specially constructed so that they can also be used as road vehicles are classified as aircraft. Amphibious motor vehicles are classified as motor vehicles.
- 4. Unless otherwise provided, the provisions of general note 2 of Section XVI concerning incomplete machines, parts of machines and unassembled machines apply to vehicles and to transport equipment falling under Section XVII.
- 5. Tools forming a normal part of the equipment of a vehicle with which they are imported or exported are treated in the same manner as the corresponding vehicle.

Chapter 86

- 2. Optical elements for apparatus of a kind falling within this Chapter and imported or exported separately are in every case treated according to their nature.
- 3. Instruments, machines and apparatus complete except for minor parts are not treated as parts but as complete instruments, machines and apparatus. Unassembled instruments, machines and apparatus are treated in the same manner as the corresponding assembled articles even when minor parts are missing.

### Chapter 92

Musical instruments, sound recorders and reproducers

General notes.

- 1. This chapter does not include:
  - a) Cinematographic sound films (Chapter 37);
  - b) Sound recorders and sound reproducers for photoelectrically recorded films and sound heads therefor (Chapter 90); c) Toy musical instruments (Chapter 97);

  - d) Collectors' pieces (Chapter 99).
- 2. This chapter includes musical instruments, wholly or partly of precious metal or rolled precious metal. The same applies to parts and accessories of musical instruments.
- 3. Parts and accessories of musical instruments are specified with the corresponding instruments except for articles of a kind falling within items 9213 11 to 9213 90. Parts and accessories of a kind suitable for several musical instruments are to be admitted under the item involving the highest rate of duty. General purpose parts and accessories (e.g. hinges, handles and metal fittings) are to be treated according to their nature if imported or exported separately. The same applies to electrical or other equipment, to clock movements and to mechanical movements not fitted with escapements if they are not prepared so as to be recognisable as parts or accessories of musical instruments.
- 4. Gramophone records, perforated paper and paperboard records and the like are invariably to be classified as separate articles.
- 5. Amplifying equipment and loud-speakers not forming an integral part of a sound reproducer are classified according to their nature.

### Chapter 99

Works of art, collectors' pieces and antiques

General note.

This Chapter does not include:

- a) Unused postage, revenue and similar stamps which are valid within the country of their issue (Chapter 49);
- b) Theatrical scenery, studio backgrounds and the like made of painted woven fabrics (Chapter 59);
- c) Pearls and precious stones, worked or unworked (Chapter 71);
- d) Sculptures having a commercial character (e.g. reproductions and castings); they are treated according to their nature.
- 9901 00 Pictures, paintings, drawings and pastels executed entirely by hand

Note.

Frames around pictures, paintings or drawings are treated in the same manner as the framed article; if, however, the value of the frame is greater than the value of the framed article, the frame is to be classified according to its nature.

9902 00 Original prints (e.g. engravings, etchings and lithographs) kg.& number

Note.

- Original prints are impressions of plates produced by the artist wholly by hand; the prints must be obtained directly and by hand and signed and numbered by the artist. Classification is not affected by the material of which the products consist or by their execution in black or in colour or by the process of production. This does not apply to products made by any mechanical or photo-mechanical process.
- 2. Frames of original prints are classified in the same manner as frames of pictures, paintings or drawings (cf. note to item 9901 00).
