INTRODUCTORY NOTE

The purpose of the annually published "Statistical Compass" is to present to its users a brief outline of major topics and processes from economic and social life in the Federal Republic of Germany, as far as they are measurable in figures. In addition to the figures for the federal territory which in general refer to the years 1960, 1970 and 1978, it contains some comparative data relating to the individual Laender of the Federal Republic as well as to the partner states within the European Communities, based on the most up-to-date information available.

Stock figures represent mostly averages. The limited space available did not allow for the inclusion of conceptional definitions. For comments necessary to correctly interpret the figures, reference should be made to the brief footnotes.

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THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC



The Federal Republic of Germany is a democratic and social constitutional state on a parliamentary basis. Its Constitution is the "Basic Law" of 23 May 1949.

The member states of the Federal Republic are the Laender Schleswig-Holstein, Hamburg, Lower Saxony, Bremen, North Rhine-Westphalia, Hesse, Rhineland-Palatinate, Baden-Wuerttemberg, Bavaria, the Saar and Berlin (West). In Berlin (West), the implementation

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of the Basic Law is subject to certain restrictions.

Legislative power in the Federal Republic is vested in the "Bundestag" and the "Bundesrat". The Bundestag comprises 518 members, including 22 from Berlin (West) who have only a deliberative voice. According to the position after the 1976 elections, 224 members of the Bundestag belonged to the Social Democratic Party of Germany (SPD), 201 to the Christian Democratic

Union (CDU), 53 to the Christian Social Union (CSU) and 40 to the Free Democratic Party (F.D.P.). At the Bundesrat, the 45 votes of the Laender governments — including four from Berlin (West) with deliberative voting power — are divided among the 11 Laender according to the number of inhabitants. Through the Bundesrat the Laender participate in the legislation and administration of the Federation.




