

FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY

The Federal Republic of Germany is a democratic and social constitutional state on a parliamentary basis. Its Constitution is the Basic Law of 23 May 1949, last amended by the law of 27 October 1994. Since the accession of the territory of the former German Democratic Republic to the Federal Republic of Germany on 3 October 1990, the member states of the Federal Republic have been the Länder of Baden-Württemberg, Bavaria, Berlin, Brandenburg, Bremen, Hamburg, Hesse, Lower Saxony, Mecklenburg-Western Pomerania, North Rhine-Westphalia, Rhineland-Palatinate, Saarland, Saxony, Saxony-Anhalt, Schleswig-Holstein and Thuringia.

According to Article 1, Para. 1 of the Basic Law, the dignity of man is inviolable, and to respect and protect it is the duty of all state authority. If the dignity of man is the supreme value and the core of the Constitution, then a major precondition for the legitimacy of the political system is the protection of human and civil rights. The democratic system is legitimized also by the fact that, as a rule, all citizens, irrespective of their descent, education, sex and religion, decide upon who is to govern. "All state authority emanates from the people"; this is declared in the Basic Law (Art. 20, Para. 2).


Head of State of the Federal Republic of Germany is the Federal President who is elected for a five-year term by the Federal Convention especially convened for this purpose. He may be re-elected once. The Federal Convention consists of all members of the Bundestag and an equal number of members elected by the Länder Parliaments according to the rules of proportional representation. Federal Presidents of the Federal Republic of Germany were Theodor Heuss from 1949 to 1959, Heinrich Lübke from 1959 to 1969, Gustav Heinemann from 1969 to 1974, Walter Scheel from 1974 to 1979, Karl Carstens from 1979 to 1984, and Richard von Weizsäcker from 1984 to 1994. In 1994, Roman Herzog was elected to become Weizsäcker's successor.

Those parties which receive five or more percent of the second votes in the electoral territory or obtain a seat in at least three constituencies will take seats in the Bundestag (there was an exceptional regulation for the first all-German election in 1990: the parties had to obtain five percent of the second votes either in the former territory of the Federal Republic or in the new Länder). Generally, the members of the Bundestag are elected every four years.

FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY

The two chambers, Bundestag and Bundesrat, with the latter consisting of members of the Länder governments, are the legislative bodies of the Federal Republic of Germany. The Bundestag is the only state organ that is legitimized directly by the citizens. Its main functions, apart from legislation, are the scrutiny of the Federal Government and the election of the Federal Chancellor. The main activities of the Bundestag, however, are not performed in the plenum but in the committees. Through the Bundesrat, the Länder participate in the legislation and administration of the Federation, and in European Union matters. The members of the Bundesrat are appointed and recalled by the Länder Governments. They can vote only collectively per Land and are bound by the instructions given by their respective Länder Governments. The total of 68 voices is divided among the 16 Länder according to the number of their inhabitants. Each of the Länder has at least three and not more than six votes.

The Federal Government participates in the legislative process mainly by introducing bills and by its competence to issue ordinances on the basis of special legal authorization. Executive power is vested in the Federal Government to the extent that the Federation has administrative competences pursuant to Art. 83 ff. of the Basic Law. It consists of the Federal Chancellor who is elected by the Bundestag on the proposal of the Federal



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President, and the Federal Ministers who are appointed and dismissed by the Federal President on the proposal of the Federal Chancellor.

Under the Basic Law, judicial authority is vested in the judges. It is exercised by the Federal Constitutional Court, the federal courts provided for in the Basic Law and the courts of the Länder, with the Federal Constitutional Court in its capacity as the "Guardian of the Constitution" occupying a special position. It decides in particular on the interpretation of the Basic Law in the event of constitutional disputes between government organs, on the compatibility of federal and Länder law with the Basic Law (judicial review) as well as on complaints lodged by individual citizens in constitutionality matters.

The jurisdiction of the Federation – not regarding the Federal Constitutional Court – is limited to the supreme courts of ordinary jurisdiction (Federal Court of Justice), administrative jurisdiction (Federal Administrative Court), financial jurisdiction (Federal Finance Court), labour jurisdiction (Federal Labour Court) and social jurisdiction (Federal Social Court) as well as the Federal Patent Court and the Federal Disciplinary Court. In addition to their own higher courts, the Länder also have courts of intermediate and lower instance.


After the end of World War II, Germany played an active part in the process of European unification. As early as May 1948, at the First Congress of the Hague, delegates from 19 European countries demanded that a European assembly be convened. This was the first initiative in forming the Council of Europe in Strasbourg.

In April 1951, the Federal Republic of Germany, France, Italy, the Netherlands, Belgium, and Luxembourg signed the Treaty on the European Coal and Steel Community (ECSC). Founding the European Economic Community (EEC) in 1957 and the European Atomic Energy Community (EURATOM), they extended their joint policy to new sectors of economic activity. Great Britain and Northern Ireland, Denmark, and Ireland acceded to the Community in 1973, Greece in 1981, Spain and Portugal in 1986.

Immediately when the EEC was founded, there were plans to establish a common market. The first steps towards this goal were the dismantling of customs barriers between the member countries and the introduction of a common external tariff. When the single European market was established in 1993, the liberalization of the movement of persons and capital and of the


Population of the EU countries, 1993

supply of services was implemented, too. Since the European economic area was established on 1 January 1994, the internal market has covered both the member states of the European Union (EU) and the EFTA states (except for Switzerland). In 1993, about 348 million people lived in the twelve countries of the European Community. As a result of Austria's, Finland's and Sweden's accession to the European Union, its population has increased by 22 million, thus being by far larger than, for instance, that of the United States of America (258 mn), the Russian Federation (149 mn) or Japan (124 mn).

Pursuant to the Treaty on European Union signed in Maastricht on 7 February 1992, a common foreign and security policy shall serve as a basis for a common European defence policy. A stage-by-stage plan defines the way towards an economic and monetary union which will be characterised by a single European currency and an independent European central bank system. Besides, the Treaty provides those citizens of the Union living in a member state whose citizenship they do not possess with the opportunity to exercise their right to vote and stand for election to the European Parliament in the place of their residence. The first opportunity to exercise this right was the 1994 European election.



Age structure of the population of Germany on 1 January 1994















Shares of individual groups of expenditure in the consumption expenditure of households, 1994






Per 100 000 inhabitants







Monthly gross domestic product (GDP) per economically active person monthly Monthly gross wages and salaries (earnings) per employee



Total area, 1993, by types of use¹⁾




