






### Gross domestic product, real change


General government revenue and expenditure





Population in relation to Germany 2020 1,000

















### Unemployment rate and youth unemployment rate



Index of industrial production 2010=100



















Carbon dioxide emissions in relation to Germany 2019 tonnes per capita




