General note.

This chapter does not include:

- a) Parings and other similar waste of untanned hides or skins (Chapter 5);
- b) Birdskins and parts of birdskins with their feathers, unworked or simply preserved (Chapter 5) or prepared or mounted (Chapter 67);
- c) Raw hides or skins with their hair or fur (Chapt. 43). However, raw hides and skins, with their hair or fur, of bovine cattle (including buffalo), of equine animals or other solipeds, of swine (including peccary), of chamois, or reindeer, of elk or of deer, and of sheep or goats, except curled skins of lambs (so-called astrakhan or caracul [Persian, broadtail or the like]), skins of Indian lamb or skins of Mongolian, Tibet or Yemen goats or kids, fall within items 4101 11 to 4101 90;

 - b) Prepared surgical catgut and goods of gold-beater's skin put up as wound dressings or for surgical use (Chapter 30);
 - c) Gloves made wholly of furskin (Chapter 43);
 - d) String or net bags (Section XI);
 - e) Footwear and parts of footwear (Chapter 64);
 - f) Headgear and parts of headgear (Chapter 65);
 - g) Whips or riding crops (Chapter 66);
 - h) Strings for musical instruments (Chapter 92);
 - i) Furniture wholly or partly covered with natural or artificial leather (Chapter 94);
 - k) Toys or sporting goods (Chapter 97); sporting gloves fall under this chapter;
 - l) Buttons (Chapter 98).
2. Articles of apparel in leather and accessories thereto lined with fur are deemed to be articles of furskin or of reconstituted fur, as the case may be, as are articles of apparel of leather and accessories thereto with fur on the outside when such fur constitutes more than mere trimming. Except where otherwise provided, trimmings of fur do not affect the classification of such articles falling under this chapter.
3. Except where otherwise provided, articles covered with natural or artificial leather are deemed to be articles of natural or artificial leather, irrespective of the nature of the backing.
4. Unfinished or incomplete articles of a kind falling under this chapter are classed with the finished articles when they are recognisable as parts of such articles; otherwise they are classified according to their kind.

General note.

 - c) Wood charcoal made up for sale as medicinal drug (Chapter 30);

 - e) Articles made from interlaced chipwood or bark (Chapter 46);
 - f) Clogs, footwear with wooden soles and parts thereof (Chapter 64);
 - g) Walking sticks, sticks, handles and other parts of umbrellas or of sunshades (Chapter 66);

Parts and accessories of other materials than wood (e.g. plates of glass or marble) are disregarded for the purpose of classifying articles falling under this chapter even where they are not attached to the articles of wood to which they belong, provided the parts and accessories are imported or exported at the same time.
3. Except where otherwise provided, impregnation, injection and printing do not affect the classification of wood or articles of wood.
4. Articles of "improved" or artificial wood are deemed to be articles of wood if not otherwise provided.

 - c) Esparto grass (alfa, spartoglass) and reeds, neither laminated nor crushed nor combed, or broom stalks (Chapter 14);
 - d) Asbestos fibre (Chapter 25) or articles of asbestos (Chapter 68);
 - e) Medicated or aseptic wadding (Chapter 30);
 - f) Synthetic or artificial textile material in the form of artificial horsehair of a diameter exceeding one millimetre, strips (artificial straw and the like) of a width exceeding five millimetres and imitation catgut (Chapter 39);
 - g) Rubberised yarn, woven fabrics or felt of a kind falling under Chapter 40;
 - h) Woolled skins (Chapter 41);
 - i) Textile articles of a kind falling under items 4202 21 to 4202 97 (e.g. travel goods and handbags) (Chapter 42);
 - k) Manufactures of wicker and other plaiting material (Chapter 46);
 - l) Cellulose wadding (Chapter 48);
 - m) Albums and child's picture-books of woven fabrics (Chapter 49);
 - n) Footwear, gaiters and leggings and similar articles of textiles and parts thereof, (Chapter 64), except footwear without applied soles made of woven or knitted textiles;
 - o) Headgear and parts of headgear (Chapter 65);
 - p) Hairnets of textiles or human hair (Chapter 65 or 67);
 - q) Animal hair prepared for use in postiche (Chapt. 67);
 - r) Grinding material on a support of fabric and sheets of mica-splittings on a support of fabric, brake-linings and clutch-linings on a support of textiles (Chapter 68);
 - s) Glass fibre and articles of glass fibre (Chapter 70);
 - t) Parachutes and parachute-accessories (Chapter 88);
 - u) Games, toys and sports goods, parts and accessories, especially sports nets (Chapter 97).
2. Definitions of textiles
 - a) Throughout this Commodity Classification - with the exception of Chapter 50 - silk is deemed to be the actual silk (cocoon-yarn, grège yarn and thread thereof), schappe silk and bourette silk (pure, mixed and thread thereof);
 - b) For the purpose of Chapter 50 silk is deemed to be cocoon yarn, grège yarn and thread thereof;

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- c) Synthetic textiles are deemed to be extruded filaments produced from substances obtained by chemical synthesis (e.g. polyamides, polyvinyl derivatives) as well as fibres of this kind;
 - d) Artificial textiles are deemed to be extruded filaments of substances obtained by the chemical transformation of natural materials (e.g. cellulose, proteins, algae) as well as fibres of this kind:
3. Definition of yarn.
The following items are treated:
- a) As undischarged or unbleached yarn:
Yarn in which the constituent textile is of a natural colour and which has not undergone any process of bleaching, dyeing or printing except colouring with a fugitive dye removable by washing with soap; Yarn wholly or partly consisting of waste fibres of indeterminate colours (grisaille yarn);
 - b) As bleached yarn:
Yarn which has been bleached either before or after spinning;
Yarn which has been discharged before or after spinning;
Yarn dyed white;
 - c) As dyed yarn:
Yarn which has been dyed before or after spinning, excluding yarn dyed white or merely dyed with fugitive dyes;
Cream-coloured yarn, single-coloured twist yarn and yarn spun from fibres of mixed colours;
Yarn coated with varnishes or metallic powder. Yarn metallised by electric-plating is regarded as metallised yarn falling under Chapter 57;
 - d) As printed yarn:
Dyed yarn subsequently printed;
So-called flake yarn and veined yarn.
4. A. Yarn prepared for retail sale is deemed to be yarn:
- a) On cards, reels, tubes or similar supports or in balls or hanks when the quantity per article does not exceed two hundred grammes (including support) in the case of linen yarn, one hundred and twenty-five grammes (including support) in the case of wool and cotton yarn, or five hundred metres in the case of other yarns;
 - b) In skeins of a weight not exceeding one hundred and twenty-five grammes;
 - c) In skeins of any weight comprising several smaller connected skeins, each of a uniform weight not exceeding one hundred and twenty-five grammes separated by dividing threads.
- B. In no case, however, will the following yarns be deemed to be yarns put up for retail sale:
- a) Single yarn whatever the form of presentation;
 - b) All textile yarn on cops or conical bobbins.
5. A. The following items are deemed to be twine, cordage and rope:
- a) Single yarn of hemp, broom, manila hemp, jute, false jutes, sisal and other fibres of the agave family of a diameter exceeding one and a half millimetres;

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- b) Coir yarn consisting of more than three threads irrespective of diameter;
- c) Other yarn:
 - 1) Polished yarn of any diameter, whether or not twined, other than cotton, flax, hemp or broom yarn on bobbins, tubes, cards or similar supports;
 - 2) Unpolished yarn of a diameter exceeding two millimetres, whether or not twined.
- B. The following are not to be treated as twine, cordage and rope:
 - a) Yarns of wool, animal hair or horsehair in any proportion which are in all cases classified as yarn irrespective of diameter;
 - b) Messina hair, imitation catgut of silk or synthetic or artificial textile materials or artificial horsehair, which are classified according to their kind (Chapter 39, 50 and 52).
- 6. Definition of woven fabrics.
The following items are treated:
 - a) As undischarged and unbleached woven fabrics:
Fabrics woven from undischarged or unbleached yarn which have not undergone any process of bleaching or dyeing, including woven fabrics impregnated with colourless preparations;
 - b) As bleached woven fabrics:
Woven fabrics bleached in the piece or woven from bleached yarn or from yarn to be treated as bleached yarn;
Woven fabrics woven from unbleached and undischarged or bleached yarn or yarn to be treated as bleached yarn;
Discharged woven fabrics;
Fabrics dyed white;
 - c) As dyed woven fabrics:
Woven fabrics dyed in the piece or woven from yarn dyed with a single colour and shade, excluding woven fabrics dyed white;
Cream-coloured fabrics;
 - d) As woven fabrics made of coloured yarn:
Fabrics woven with yarns of different colours;
Fabrics woven with yarns of different shades;
Woven fabrics consisting of unbleached or bleached yarns together with coloured yarns;
Woven fabrics of mixed dyed yarns.
No account is to be taken of selvages and ends in above cases;
 - e) As printed woven fabrics:
Woven fabrics printed in one or more colours or shades after weaving;
Shadowy fabrics produced by a printed pattern on the warp before weaving;
Fabrics woven from printed yarn, flake yarn or veined yarn;
Fabrics woven from undischarged or unbleached, bleached or dyed yarn and printed yarn, flake yarn or veined yarn.
The following are, furthermore, treated as printed woven fabrics:
Woven fabrics with painted, stencilled, sprayed or acidprinted patterns or with coloured patterns otherwise applied after weaving;

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Woven fabrics printed by means of textile dust.
Painted woven fabrics of uniform colour are, however, treated in the same manner as coated fabrics (Chapter 59);

- f) As unfigured woven fabrics, except tulle and net fabrics:
Woven fabrics of which each surface is wholly composed of one of the basic weaves, namely canvas or taffeta weaves, twill or serge weaves and satin weaves;
 - g) As broché fabrics:
Figured woven fabrics, in which the effect or pattern is obtained by means of one or more threads, independent of the foundation fabric, which may be removed without detriment to the foundation fabric; Broché fabrics are also deemed to be fabrics in which the effect or pattern, independent of the foundation fabric, is obtained by means of a supplementary warp or weft;
 - h) As woven fabrics for furnishings and interior decorating:
Textile materials for furniture covers, heavy draperies and curtains and table-covers of a weight exceeding two hundred and fifty grammes per square metre.
7. Moiré work, embossing and similar mechanical treatments after weaving do not affect the classification of woven fabrics.
8. Gimped yarn, braid yarn, crochet yarn and chenille yarn are classified under trimmings.
9. Goods of mixed textiles:
- A. General definitions.
Except where otherwise provided, textile goods containing two or more textiles are classified as follows:
 - a) Goods of mixed textiles in which the weight of silk, schappe or bourette (Chapter 50) amounts to more than 10 per cent of the total weight of the textiles are classed with goods of the same kind composed of these textiles; goods of mixed textiles containing two or more of those textiles are classified with such item of Chapter 50 that relates to the textile fibre predominating in weight;
 - b) Goods of mixed textiles not falling under a) and whose warp consists wholly of artificial or synthetic filaments are deemed to be woven fabrics of artificial or synthetic filaments (Chapter 52);
 - c) Goods of mixed textiles other than those mentioned under a) and b) are classed with goods of the same kind consisting of the textile which predominates in weight;
 - d) If the conditions as set out under a) paragraph 2 and under c) apply and not only one of several textiles predominates in weight, or if all the textiles are of the same weight classification is determined by the textile which involves the highest rate of duty.

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Where the appropriate rates of duty are the same or where merely exemption from duty is provided, the goods of mixed textiles are admitted under the heading or sub-heading which appears first in the Tariff.

- e) Metallised yarn is regarded for its total weight as yarn of a single (separate) textile material. The same applies to metal threads in textile articles.

B. Special definitions.

For the purpose of the above rule the following are disregarded:

- a) The backing or foundation of cut or uncut velvet and plush. The same applies also to narrow woven fabrics of velvet and plush, and to all kinds of carpets made like woven fabrics of velvet and plush or with a foundation of canvas;
- b) In the case of chenille yarn or fabrics the yarn supporting the chenille;
- c) The core or filling of trimmings;
- d) The nature of the thread of embroidery other than chemical embroidery or embroidery without a visible ground;
- e) In the case of all articles, the rubber or other non-textile matters used for the fabrication of those goods (e.g. woven in, plaited in or worked in), excepting no other provisions having been made.

10. Made-up textile articles.

- A. For the purpose of goods falling under Chapters 61 to 62 textile goods are regarded as made up;

- a) Cut otherwise than into squares or rectangles;
- b) Woven ready for use and not requiring cutting, sewing or other further fabrication (e.g. dusters, towels, table-cloths and scarf squares);
- c) Hemmed or with rolled edges or with knotted fringes (from the threads of the woven fabrics or from threads attached to it afterwards);
- d) Cut to size in any form and having undergone a process of drawn thread work;
- e) Assembled by sewing, gumming or otherwise.

- B. Made up articles hemmed merely by means of an embroidery stitch without further embroidery are not regarded as embroidered.

11. Articles of apparel and other made up textile articles.

- A. For statistical purposes no account is being taken of: Collars, ruffs, lapels, cuffs, edgings, emblems, insignia, ribbons or other portions; except where otherwise provided linings and padding or other textile articles constituting the interior make-up of clothing.

- B. Except where otherwise provided clothing and other made up articles composed of two or more different textiles are classified as if composed solely of the textile article defining the type of the composite article.

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When in doubt the textile goods are to be classified as if composed of the constituent textile which involves the highest rate of duty for the article.

In applying this rule account is to be taken of any goods consisting of two or more textiles with regard to their statistical treatment in accordance with the provisions as set out in note 9 above.

Where the appropriate rates of duty are the same or where merely exemption from duty has been provided, the composite articles are to be classified under the item specified first in the Tariff Nomenclature.

Chapter 67

Prepared ornamental feathers and articles made with feathers;
artificial flowers, articles of human hair; fans.

General notes.

1. This chapter does not include:
 - a) Straining cloth of hair (Chapter 59);
 - b) Flower motifs of lace or embroidery (Section XI);
 - c) Headgear of feather or artificial flowers (Chapter 65);
 - d) Pillows and other bedding in which feathers constitute only filling or padding (Chapter 94);
 - e) Feather dusters of all kinds, hair sieves (Chapter 96);
 - f) Toys, sports' goods and carnival articles (Chapt.97);
 - g) Imitation flowers, foliage or fruits, including parts thereof, of ceramics, glass or carved or moulded materials (Chapters 69, 70 and 95), gold smiths' and silver smiths' ware and jewellery of all kinds of metal (Chapter 71).
2. Artificial flowers, parts thereof and fans of feather fall under items 6704 90, 6705 90 or 6709 00 and not under item 6703 00.
3. In classifying artificial flowers, foliage or fruits no account is taken of materials used for the making up of the stems, stamens or pistils, or as padding.
