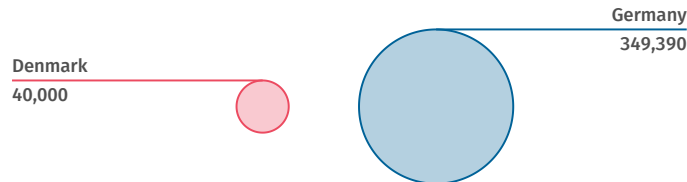

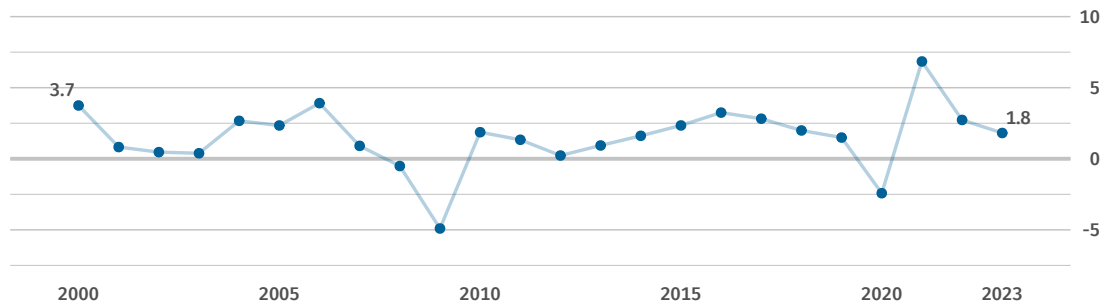

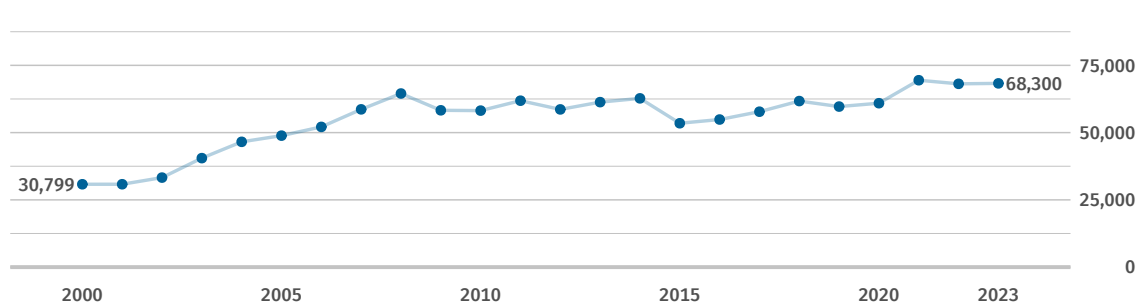

% on previous year



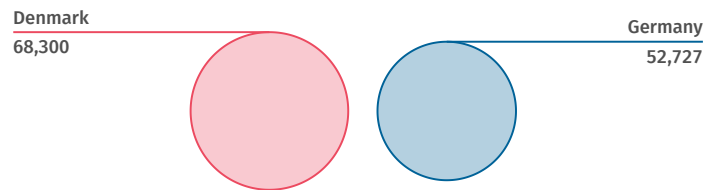

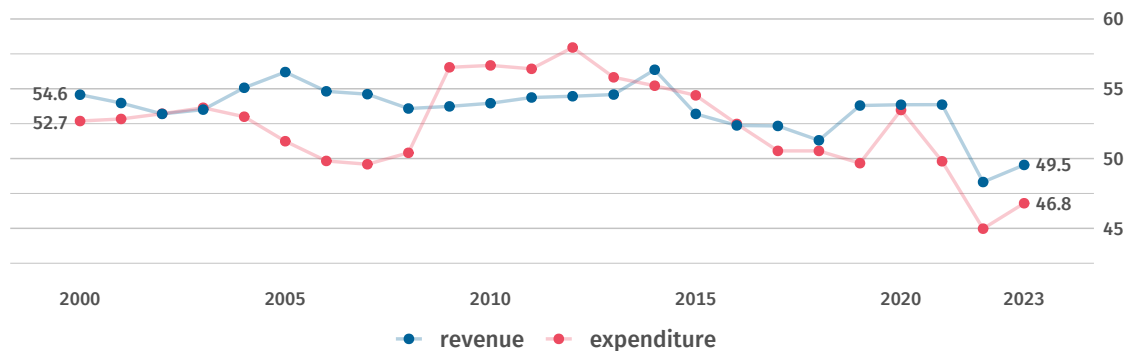

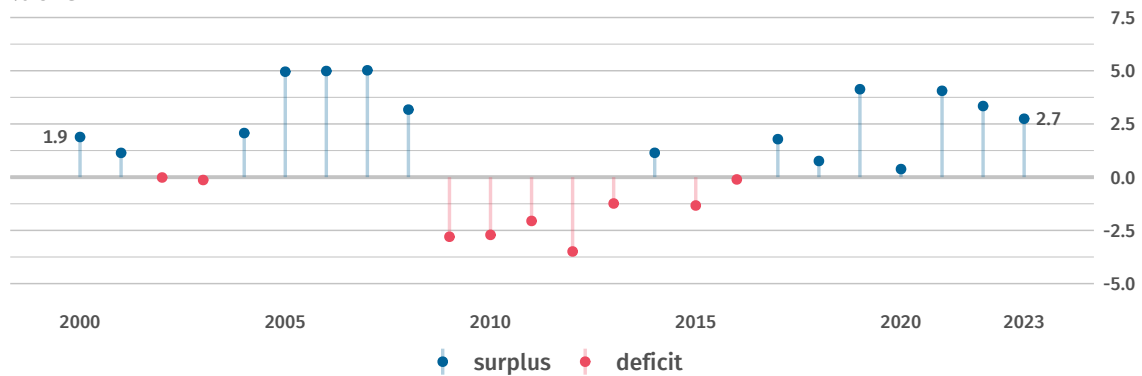

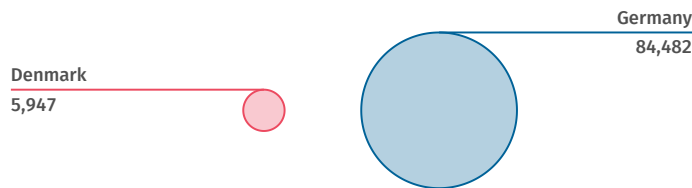

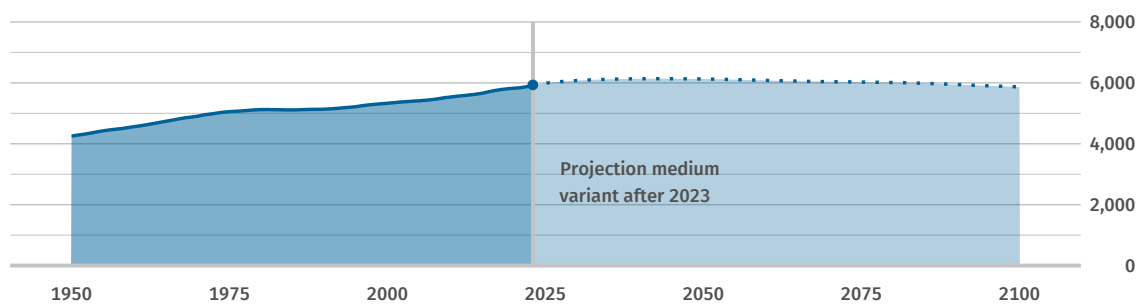

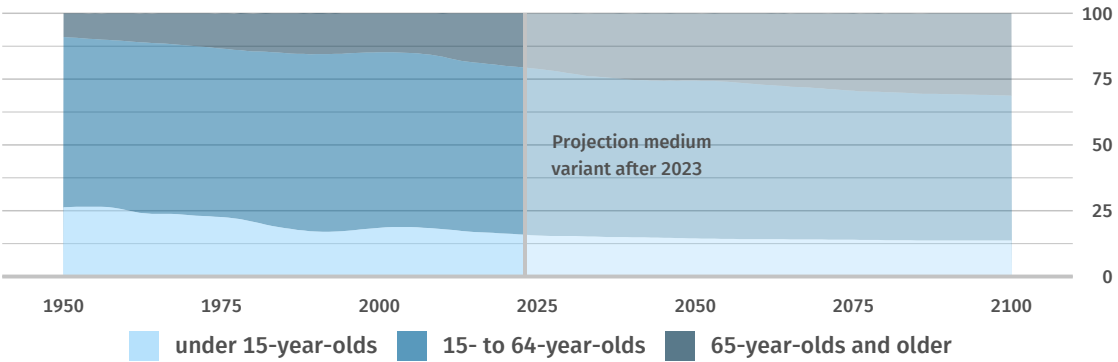

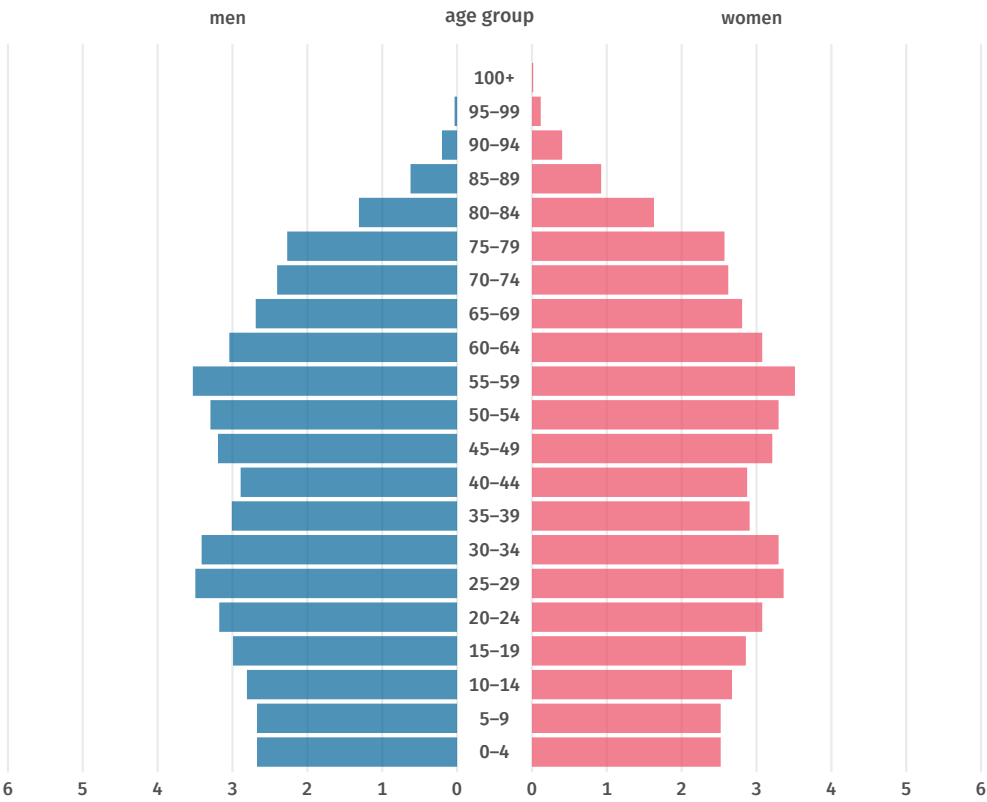

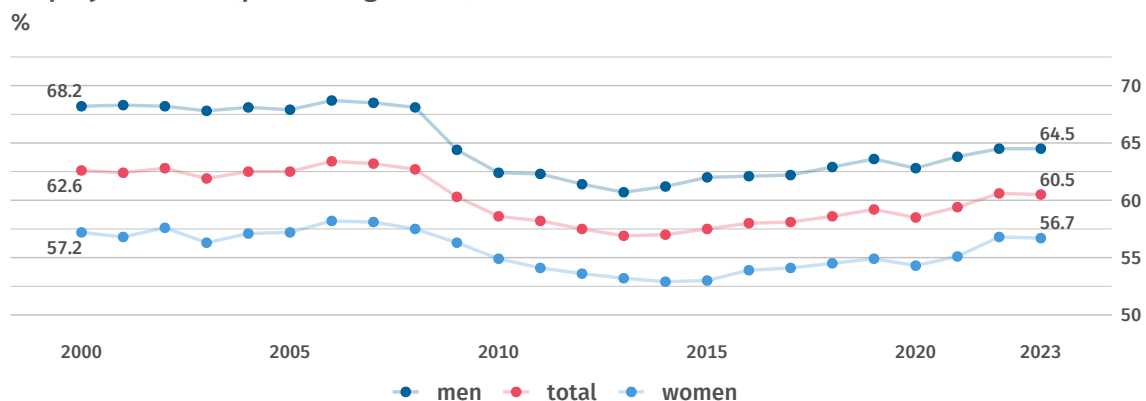

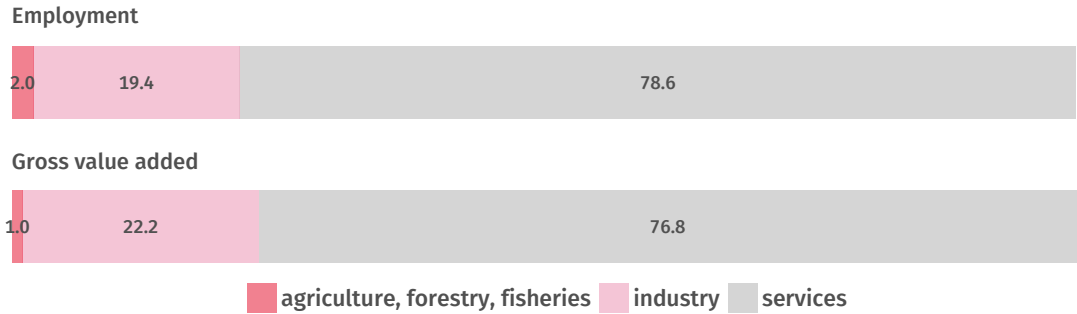

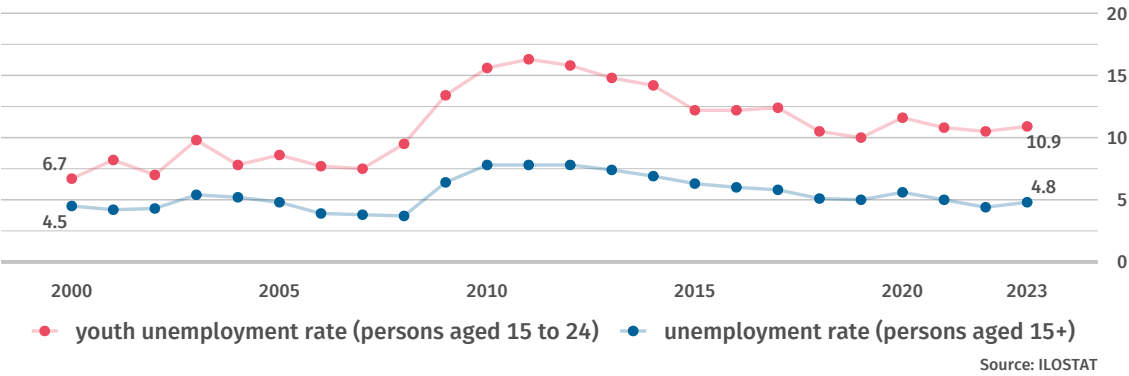

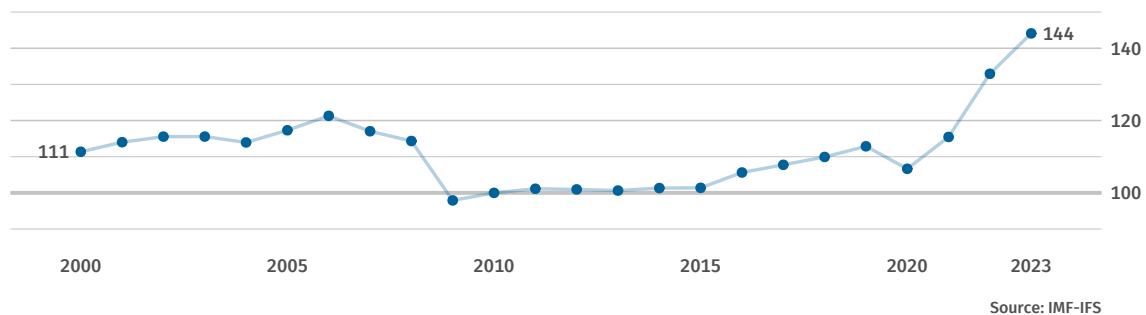

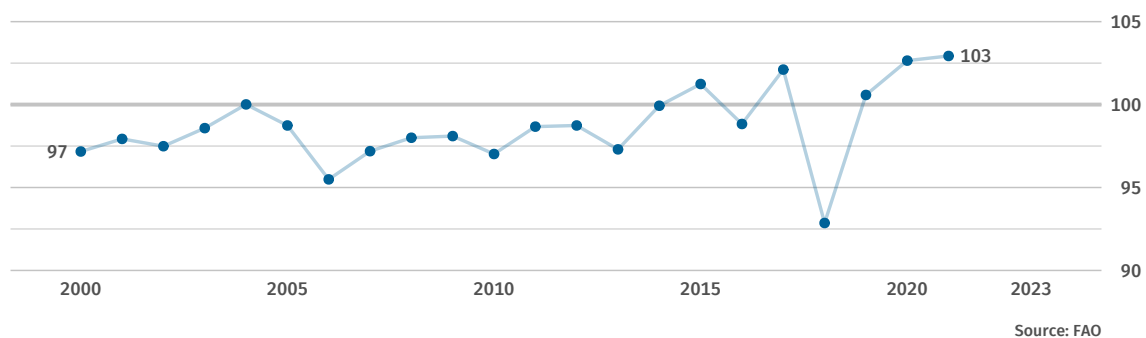

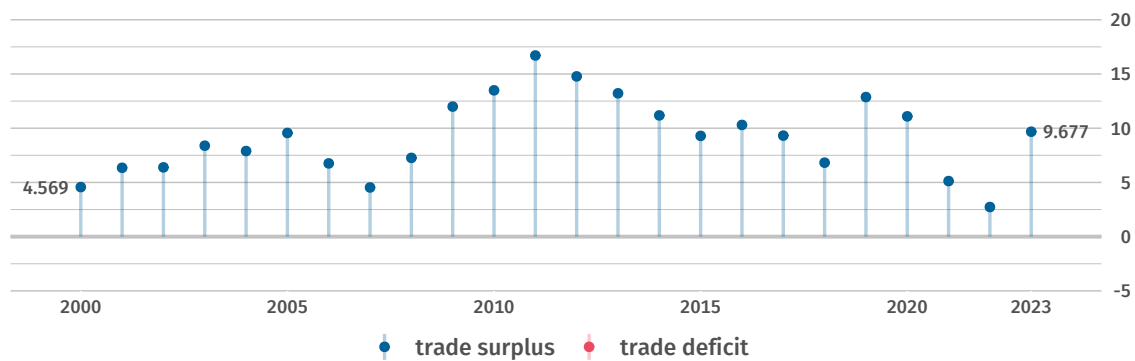

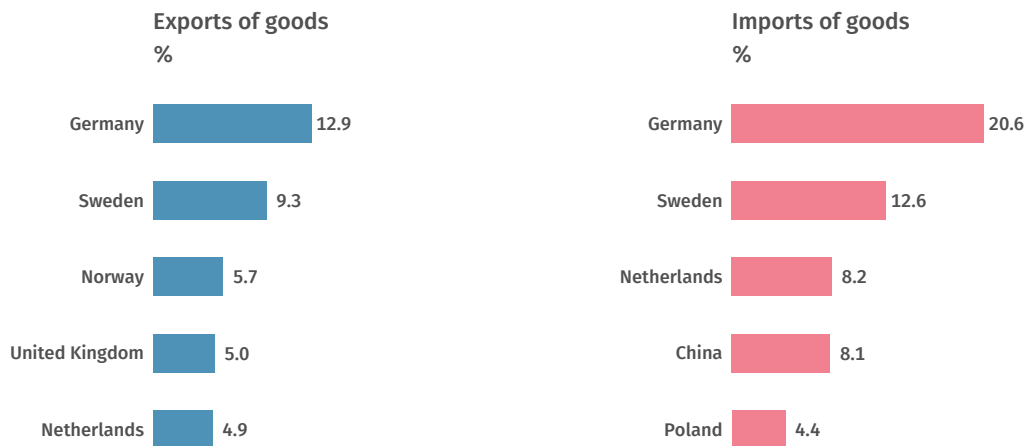

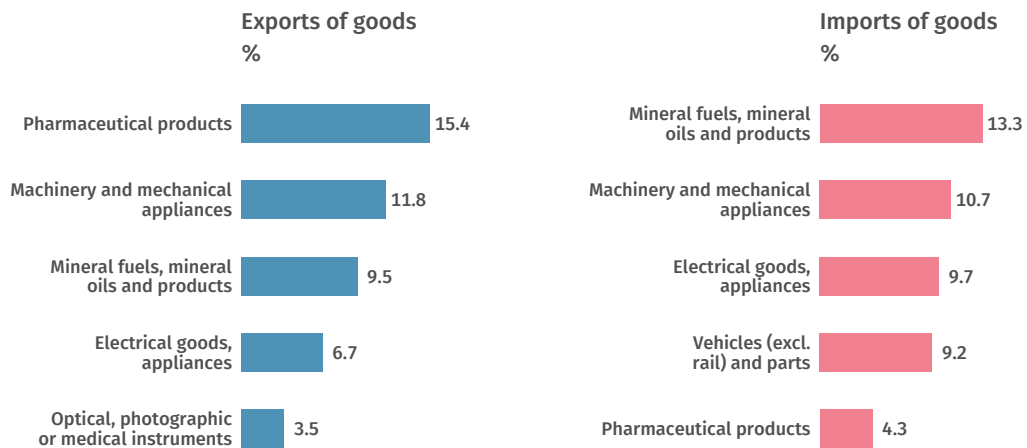

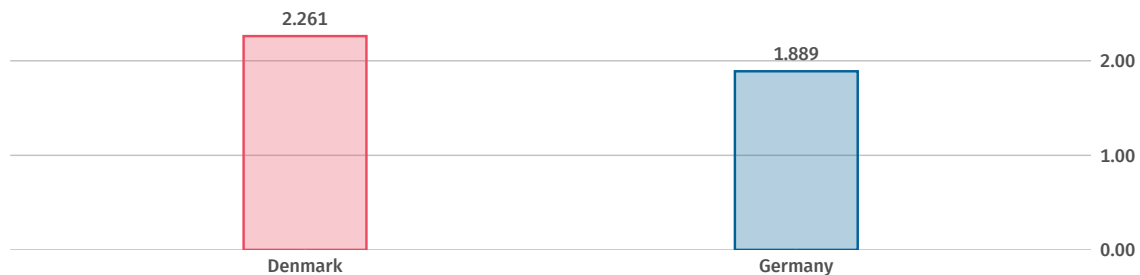

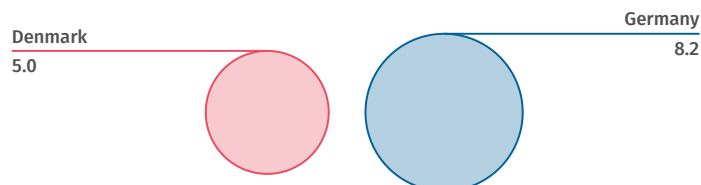

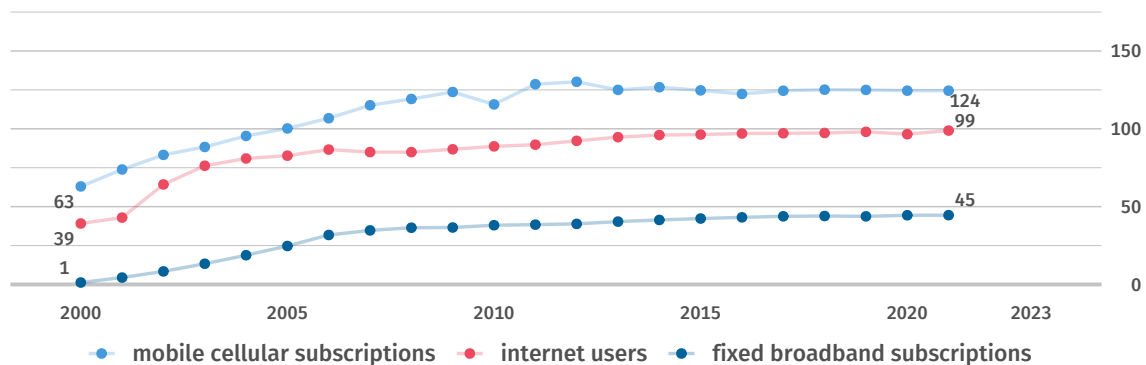
