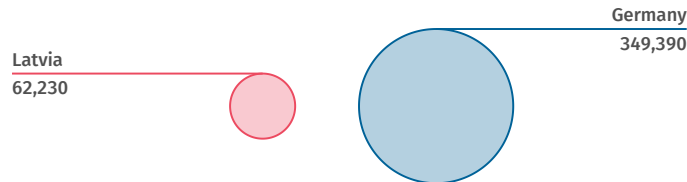

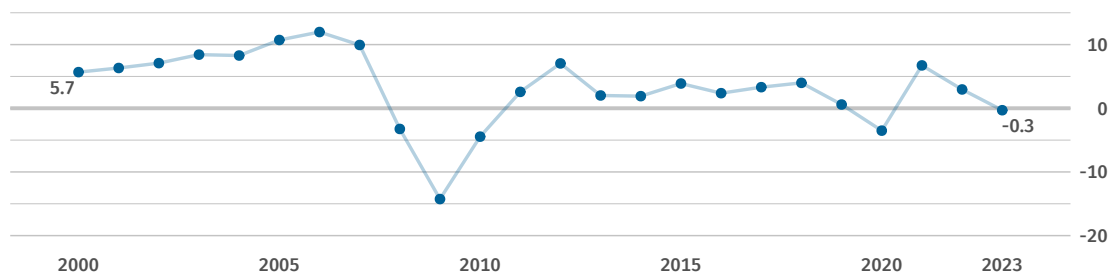

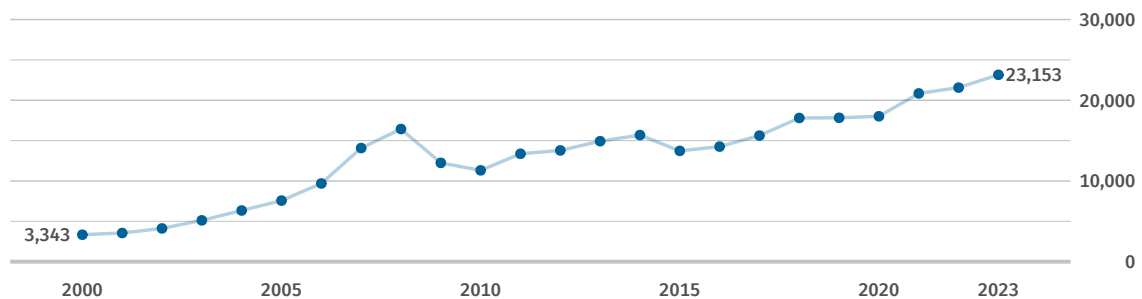

% on previous year



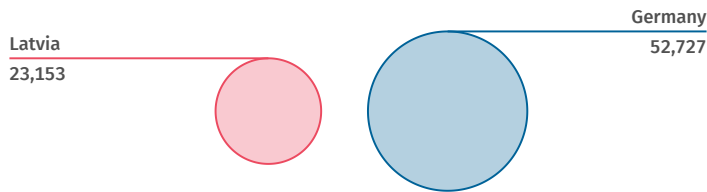

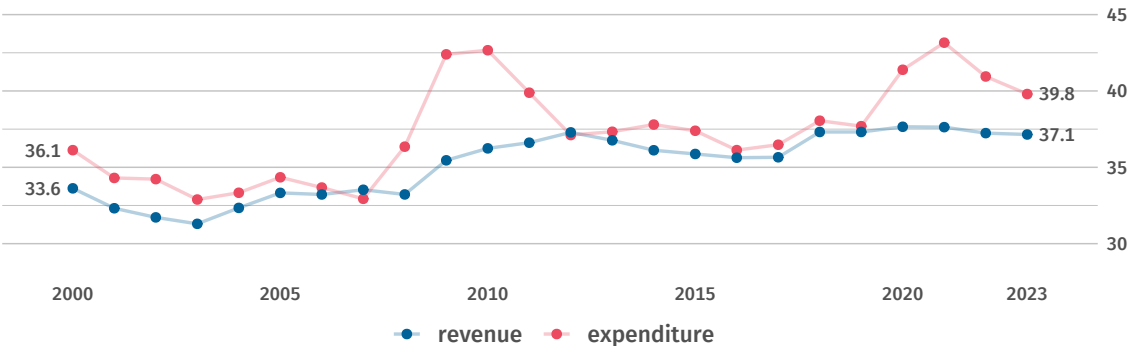

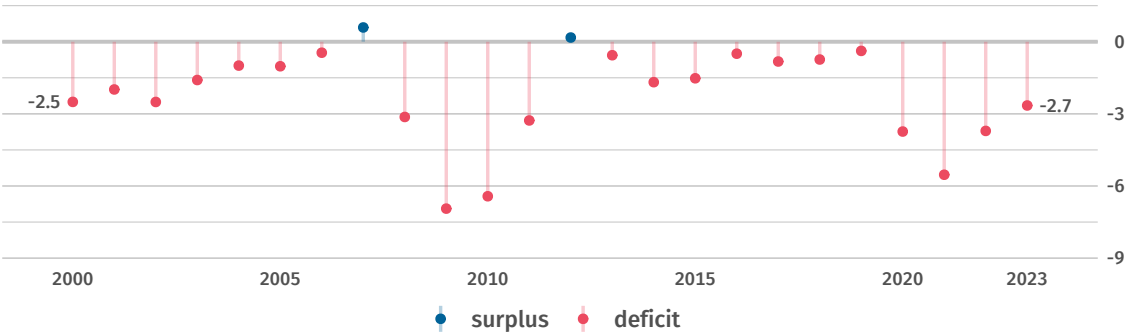

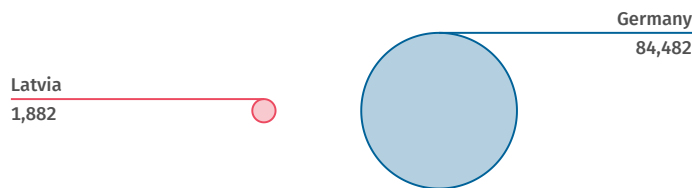

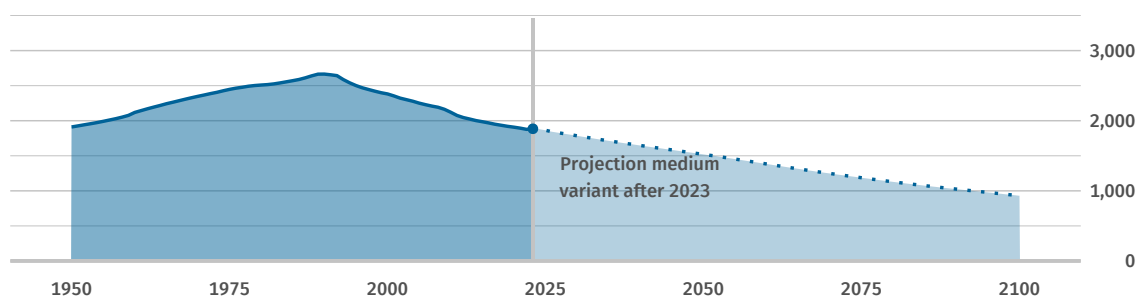

Population in relation to Germany, 2023 1,000



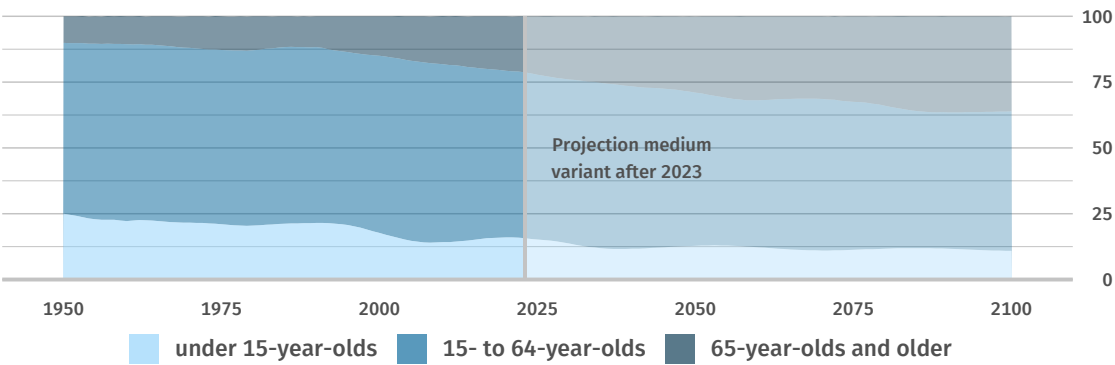

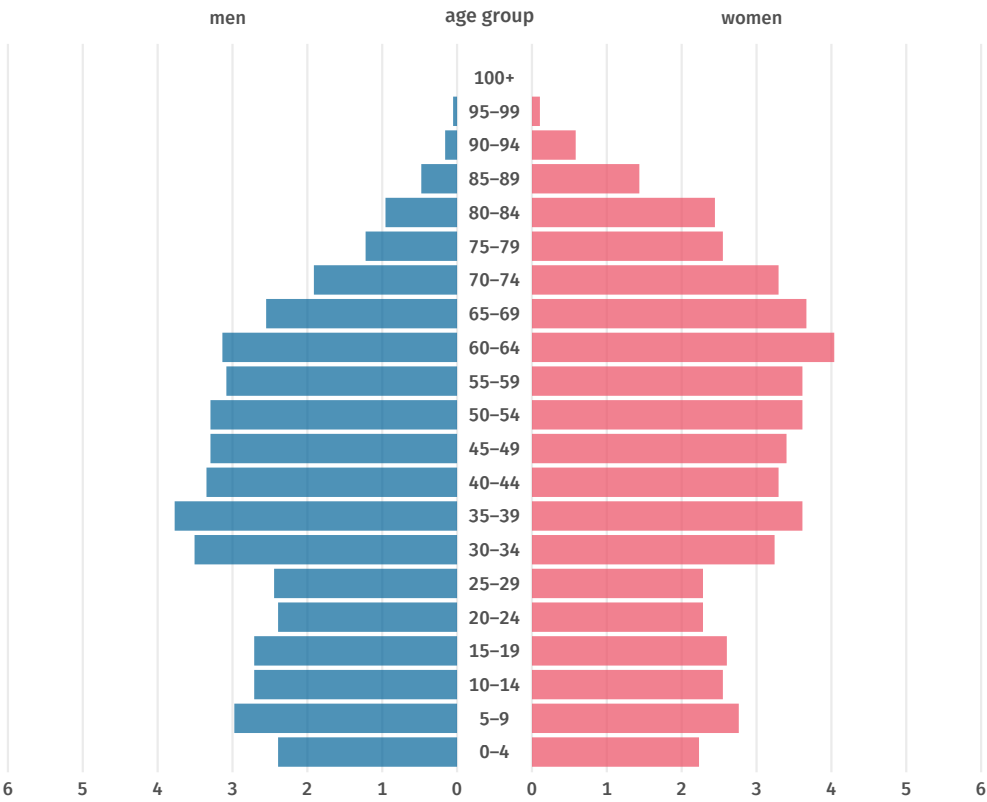

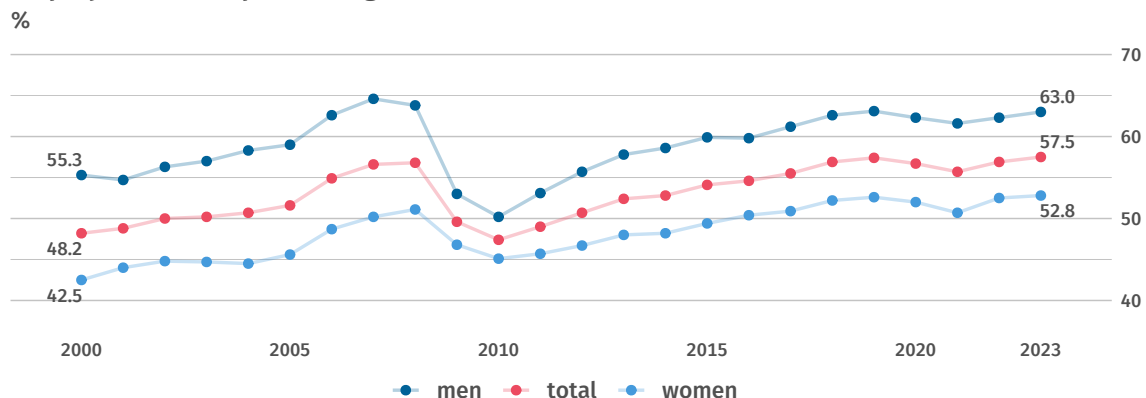

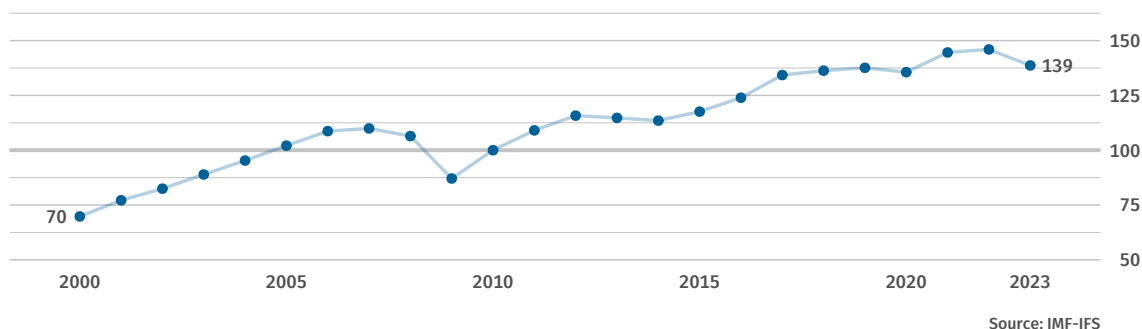

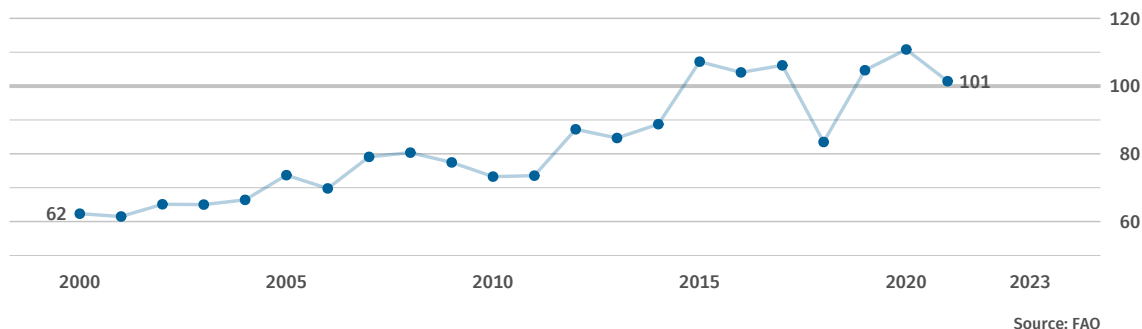

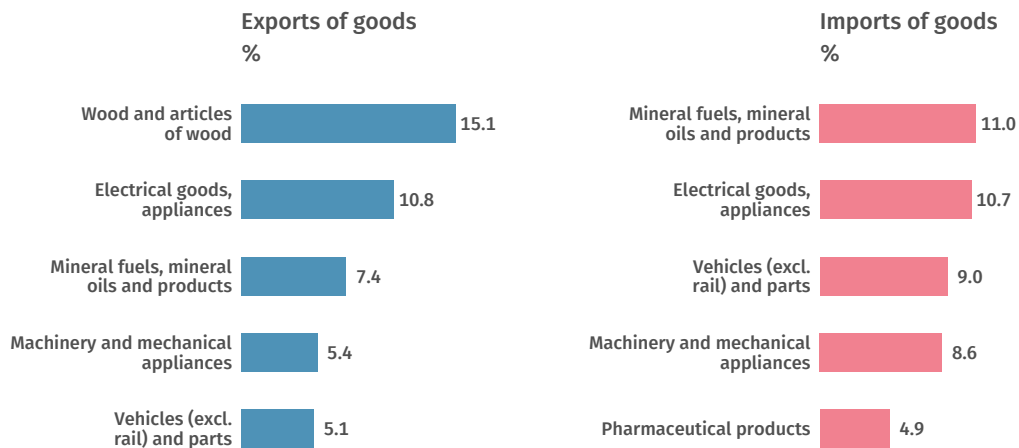

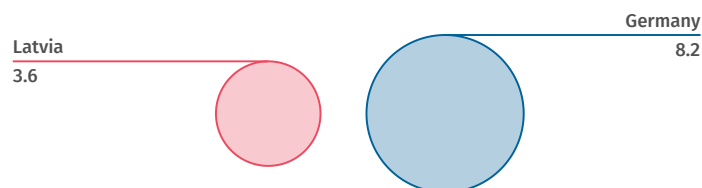

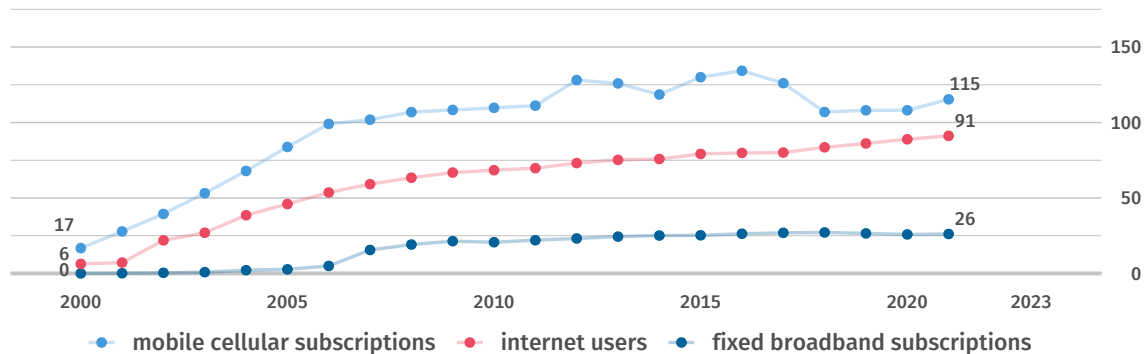
